TOWN BOARD MEETING  
COLDEN SENIOR CENTER – April 20, 2015

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:30PM.

SUPERVISOR DEPASQUALE OPENED THE MEETING WITH A MOMENT OF SILENCE  
FOLLOWED BY THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.

1) Creek Stabilization

Supervisor DePasquale stated that the Town Board received the template and instructions for the grant funding for the West Cazenovia Creek Sediment & Nutrient Control Project working with the Erie County Soil & Water Conservation District.

Councilman Pietraszek explained that Mark Gaston from Erie County Conservation is heading up the grant and has indicated that the Town has a good chance of receiving grant funding. The stream bank erosion control would take place from the railroad bridge down to the Town Hall and possible on the opposite bank. One thing they do not want to cause is problems downstream. Funding is available right now all the Town Board has to do tonight is seek approval for Mark Gaston to write the grant and submit it by April 24<sup>th</sup>. The project would run from July 2015 to July 2018.

MOTION made by Supervisor DePasquale and seconded by Councilman Arcara and unanimously approved for Erie County Soil and Water Conservation District Field manager Mark Gaston to write and submit a grant for the West Cazenovia Creek Streambank Stabilization Project.

The project documents can be found on the Town's website under the April 20, 2015 supporting documents and are on file in the Town Clerk's office.

2) Municipal Parking Lot on Boston Colden Road

Town Board reviewed the Municipal Parking Lot agreement with Harmony Market and discussion followed on:

Parking lot agreement with Stewart Andrews Store May 11, 1995  
Review of the Survey

Parking lot layout 19 spaces for municipal parking and four spaces for Harmony Market  
Parking lot lined and striped  
Post signs with chain link down the parking lot stating Municipal parking  
Taking sidewalk out for more parking space  
Removing one flower box and shorten up the other flower box

Decision was to put Municipal Parking lot signs up through the parking lot and separate from the Store parking. Supervisor DePasquale stated that he would contact Town Attorney Bennett to see what the limitations are for having the signs facing the Town parking lot. Highway Superintendent Clarkson will be notified to put the signs up as soon as possible.
