This meeting was scheduled to review 38 acres that are adjunct to Kummer Park that Calvin Rauch proposed to sell to the Town if interested. Land Manager Steve Andrews handed out an aerial view map of the property that is for sale and then took us all on a walkthrough of the property. The property was logged last year and previously was done twenty years before that. In the future the property would be logged in about another 15 to 18 years. There is no gas wells on the property just transmission lines that run through the property and since the lines are near the park they are replaced about every four or so years.

Ideas that were talked about were to move and or add various athletic fields, parking areas, shelters and benches added, amphitheater and trails for walking, biking and snowshoeing and cross country skiing.

The Town Board is looking into various ways of purchasing the property as well as interest from the Town residents.
