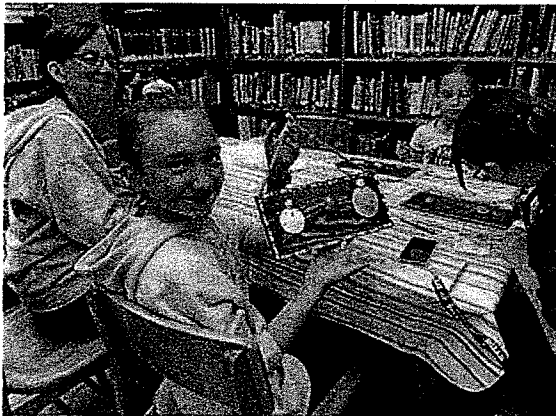
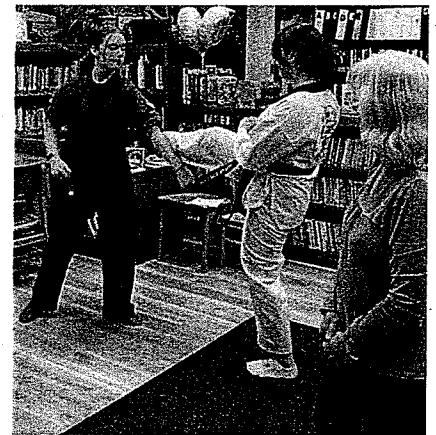
Library Activities
